
MEET AND GREET SERVICES

Representatives will wear masks and gloves, and won't accompany guests to hotels. There will be 'no garlanding' or 'aarti tikka', and 'Namaste' will be the standard greeting at every touch point. Welcome travel kits will be e-mailed to guests before travel, and no printed documents will be given. A 'covid protection kit' will be available for travellers at a supplement and our partners may opt for the same.



SIGHTSEEING

Visiting crowded places will be avoided. Similarly, special experiences such as village walks, school and community centre visits, interaction with artisans, and cooking with a family will be suspended until further notice. All guidelines as issued and mandated by state tourism boards, Ministry of Tourism and the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) will be strictly followed.



GUIDES AND TRAVEL ESCORTS

They will also play a major role in the new normal. All guides will have to don masks and gloves, while maintaining adequate distance during tours. Guides will meet guests at the monument, unless it's absolutely necessary to visit the hotel and/or travel with guests.


HOTEL SELECTION

We will select hotels that strictly abide by the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Tourism, and also follow our own health and safety protocols. These include, daily temperature checks of guests and staff and also ensuring a distance of at least six feet during interactions with guests. Reception areas must have two-meter distance markings to ensure safe check in. Rooms should have a buffer of 24 hours between each check in and check out. Staff need to use masks, gloves and sanitizers. These are just some of the points of our hotel selection policy.



TRANSPORTATION

Keeping in mind the need for social distancing, each vehicle will only utilize 50% of the seating capacity to maintain safe distance between the travellers. All the vehicles will be sanitized thoroughly post every usage. All the frequently touched spots, such as window switches, door handles, Interior lights, AC controls, Mirrors, documents pouch etc – will be sanitized with precision. The helper will be equipped with disposable gloves and masks before the sanitization process. The driver and crew – helper & cleaner – shall wear mask while travelling and in public places for their as well as our guests' safety. Face shields will be used by driver and helper for the intercity transfer and long tours.



REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS AND OTHER SERVICES

Guests will also be registered on Aarogya Setu – a mobile app developed by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. This app alerts users if they pass within six feet of an infected person and also has a plethora of other features. Room drops and gifts will be avoided. Refillable sanitized water bottles (message in a bottle) will be provided on arrival and feedback will be collected electronically.



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



TOUR OVERVIEW

Bikaner and Mandawa are renowned for their extraordinary painted havelis (traditional Indian mansions) and dazzling murals. These charming destinations still exude the relaxed vibe of a small town charm, striking fine contrast to the hustle and bustle of Jaipur. Discover the highlights of these three cities on this 4 night / 5 day tour.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: DELHI - MANDAWA (260 KMS - 6 HRS)

The drive from Delhi to Mandawa takes approx. six hours, excluding stops. On arrival, check in to your hotel.

Post lunch, stroll down the meandering small lanes of this ancient town and visit the famous havelis (traditional Indian mansions) such as Hanuman Prasad Goenka Haveli, Goenka Double Haveli and Mohan Lal Saraf Haveli. Each of these havelis reflect the opulence of the 18th and 19th centuries and have differing themes such as religion, wedding processions and fairs etc.

You may also visit various cenotaphs of the ancestors of the royal family members of Mandawa and stroll through the colourful bazaars. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 2 -MANDAWA – BIKANER (200 KMS – 3 HRS.30 MINS)

After a relaxed morning, drive to Bikaner and check in to your hotel.

There is a lot to see in Bikaner. Start your tour by visiting the Karni Mata, also known as the Temple of Rats, famous for thousands of black rats living there. Next, stop at the Junagarh Fort, a magnificent structure built in 1588 AD. The fort complex comprises a plethora of palaces, built by different rulers. Also, stop at Lalgarh Palace and Museum, where you will join a heritage walk tour. The last stop today is at the National Research Centre on Camel. The centre also has a museum and an ice cream parlour, where goodies made from camel milk are sold.

Return to your hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)

DAY 03: BIKANER – JAIPUR (260 KMS – 4 HRS. 30 MINS.)

Drive to Jaipur and check in to your hotel. No activities envisaged today. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)

DAY 04: JAIPUR

After breakfast, drive to the Hawa Mahal for a photo stop, before proceeding to Amer Fort.



The weather-beaten façade of the nearly 420-year old Amer Fort belies the elegant beauty of its majestic interiors. Some of the most spectacular structures are 'Diwan-i-Aam', 'Sheesh Mahal', and 'Sukh Mahal'.

After visiting Amer Fort, head to the Jantar Mantar – one of the world's largest ancient observatories. Many of the huge ancient instruments here are still in working condition.

Next, visit the City Palace. It's a blend of Mughal, Rajput and European architectural styles as it was built by different succeeding rulers. The Chandra Mahal (Moon Palace)

here has been turned into a museum. Now, head to Chaura Rasta, known for branded showrooms and antique bookstores. Continue through the famous Bapu bazaar and Johri bazaar. Return to your hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)

DAY 05: JAIPUR – DELHI (275 KMS – 5 HRS.30 MINS)





TOUR OVERVIEW

Located in the Shekawati region, Mandawa is a charming 18th-century settlement that exudes a laidback small-town vibe and makes for an ideal destination to explore havelis (traditional Indian mansions) and murals. Combined with Jaipur, where on one hand, the city's majestic historical landmarks transports you to the past, and on the other hand, the hustle and bustle of the markets, sprawling malls, and modern wonders brings you back on a rollercoaster-like ride to the present, this 3 nights/4 days tour is a perfect getaway for any travel enthusiast.



DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: DELHI – MANDAWA (260 KMS – 6 HRS)

Today, you will drive to Mandawa, and check in to the hotel, right after arrival. Post lunch, stroll down the meandering small lanes of this ancient town and visit the famous havelis (traditional Indian mansions) such as Hanuman Prasad Goenka Haveli, Goenka Double Haveli and Mohan Lal Saraf Haveli. Each of these havelis reflect the opulence of the 18th and 19th centuries and have differing themes such as religion, wedding processions and fairs etc.

You may also visit various cenotaphs of the ancestors of the royal family members of Mandawa and stroll through the colourful bazaars.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: MANDAWA – JAIPUR (180 KMS – 3 HRS)

After a relaxed start, drive to Jaipur and check in to your hotel.

Spend the rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: JAIPUR

After breakfast, drive to the Hawa Mahal for a photo stop, before proceeding to Amer Fort.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: DELHI – AGRA (235 KMS – 4 HRS)

The drive from Delhi to Agra, excluding stops, takes approx. four hours. On arrival, check in to the hotel.

This afternoon, start your tour of Agra at the Itmad-ud-Daulah tomb.

From here, drive to the imposing Agra Fort.

The Mughal Emperor, Akbar, rebuilt the fort as a beautiful fort palace. The work was completed by his son and grandson.

Now, drive to the Taj Mahal.

This stunning mausoleum was built for Shah Jahan's wife, Mumtaz Mahal. It has been aptly described by the poet laureate Tagore as 'A tear on the face of eternity'. Return to your hotel after sunset. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: AGRA – JAIPUR (240 KMS – 6 HRS.)

This morning, you will drive to Jaipur. The drive takes six hours, excluding stops.

Your first stop is Fatehpur Sikri, which is around two hours away from Agra. Just over 400 years old, this deserted ancient city, still presents a pristine sight.

Your next stop is the 9th century, Chand Baori stepwell – an architectural wonder with 3,500 perfectly symmetrical, narrow steps. Adjoining the Chand Baori is the Harshat Mata Temple. This 9th-10th century temple is dedicated to Harshat Mata.

Continue your drive and reach Jaipur by evening. Check in to your hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: JAIPUR

After breakfast, drive to the Hawa Mahal for a photo stop, before proceeding to Amer Fort.

The weather-beaten façade of the nearly 420-year old Amer Fort belies the elegant beauty of its majestic interiors. After visiting Amer Fort, head to the Jantar Mantar – one of the world's largest ancient observatories.

Next, visit the City Palace. It's a blend of Mughal, Rajput and European architectural styles, built by different succeeding rulers.



TOUR OVERVIEW

In the heart of Rajasthan's Thar Desert, the golden city of Jaisalmer is home to elegant old mansions, beautiful sand dunes stretching far into the horizon, a fairy-tale fort and myriad other endearing charms. With two days to spend in this magnificent town, you'll be able to take in Jaisalmer's unforgettable sights, sounds, scents and tastes at a relaxed pace.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVE JAISALMER (BY FLIGHT)

You will be met by a representative on arrival at the airport and assisted with your transfer to your hotel.

Spend the evening in leisure.
Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: JAISALMER

After breakfast, your sightseeing starts and the first destination is the legendary Jaisalmer Fort.

Built in 1156 by the Bhati Rajput ruler, the fort has been the scene of many battles. This classic desert fort, a World Heritage Site, is built of golden coloured sandstone, which looks tawny during the day, the colour subtly changing to an almost honey gold at sunset. Standing at a height of 100 meters over the city, this living fort is home to almost a quarter of the city's population,

who live within the walls of the fort.

Next, make your way through the narrow lanes towards the havelis.

The havelis of Jaisalmer are exceptional. Similar in style to the homes of Venetian merchants, they were wealthy traders, who grew rich on the flourishing trade of the era. Their houses have beautifully carved facades, jali (lattice) screens and oriole windows. Each haveli has an inner courtyard, surrounded by richly decorated living quarters.

Of these, the Patwon Ki Haveli is exceptionally captivating. After all, it's the most elaborate and the largest of Jaisalmer's havelis. In fact, the haveli's construction took as long as 50 years. We also recommend a stop at Nathmal ji ki Haveli, which is one of the last of the great havelis to be built in the late 19th century.

While visiting the havelis, you will pass small silversmith establishments, stalls selling goods made from local products and colourful shawls and blankets. Equally artistic are the homes of the ordinary folks. The flat-roofed white houses with bands of ochre and brown are decorated with folk art on the walls and geometric patterns on the floor.

Lastly, drive to Gadi Sagar Lake. During spells of drought, this lake proved to be the mainstay of the town and has many interesting stories and legends associated with it.

This evening, you will enjoy an exclusive dinner in the desert against the backdrop of the mesmerising sand dunes.

Open jeeps will ferry you to the desert and you will enjoy a cocktail, while watching a spectacular desert sunset.

Return to your hotel after sunset.
Overnight at hotel (B,D)

DAY 03: JAISALMER DEPARTURE (FLIGHT)

The tour comes to an end today.

After breakfast, check out and drive to the airport for the next leg of your onwards journey.

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

KHAJURAHO: Witness some of the finest temple art in the world

TOUR OVERVIEW

Khajuraho is well known for the captivating stone carvings etched into stark relief on the three groups of World Heritage-listed temples. The Western Group of temples, in particular, contains stunning sculptures that together make up some of the finest temple art in the world. Khajuraho in itself, is a delightful, quiet little town, perfect for spending a few days.

50-minute show is played out.

Voiced by India's movie superstar, Mr. Amitabh Bachchan, the show narrates the fascinating story of these magnificent temples and relives the life and times of the great Chandela rulers.

Return to your hotel after the show. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: KHAJURAHO DEPARTURE (BY TRAIN)

Your tour ends today. Set out after breakfast for your return drive to Jhansi, approx. 4 hrs away. In Jhansi, you board the Gatiman Express train for your onwards journey (B)

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVE KHAJURAHO (BY TRAIN)

The Bhopal Shatabdi train is a comfortable mode of transport that brings you to Jhansi.

In Jhansi, you transfer to your waiting vehicle and drive to Khajuraho. The drive is approx. 180 km and takes five hours, excluding stops.

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. Spend the evening at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: KHAJURAHO


After breakfast, drive to the UNESCO World Heritage Site, known as the 'Western Group of Temples'. Start your visit with the Kandariya Mahadev temple, the most popular and beautiful massive structure here. It is a magnificent piece of artistic sculptural work decorated with over 870 statues and carvings.

Stroll through other temples, including the Chausath Yogini Temple. Unlike other Chausath Yogini temples elsewhere, this one is rectangular in shape and not rounded. The temple dates back to the late 9th century and is said to be Khajuraho's oldest surviving temple.

In the afternoon, explore the local handicrafts of the town. In this small town, tourism accounts for the main source of earnings for its local people. Notice how nearly every household is engaged in some kind of commercial activity. Houses are

converted into budget hotels, shops and restaurants.

This evening, you also have the option to attend a captivating Sound and Light show. Set out at 18:00 hours and drive to the Western group of temples, where this

TOUR OVERVIEW

The ancient holy city of Varanasi, picturesquely situated on the crescent shaped left banks of the Ganges, is one of the oldest seats of spiritual learning in India, and the city's name is said to be a compound of the names of two streams, the Varuna and the Assi, which still flow in the north and south of the city. Since times immemorial, it has been a great one of the most sacred pilgrim destinations.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVE VARANASI (BY FLIGHT)

On arrival at Varanasi airport, you will be met by our representative, who will also help you with the transfer to your hotel.

Varanasi is the spiritual heart of India and one of the oldest living cities in the world with a history going back 2,500 years. The true name for Varanasi is 'Kashi', which is derived from a Sanskrit word meaning 'to shine and look brilliant' and Kashi (today, the old city area) is believed to be the home of the most powerful of the Triumvirate Indian deity, Lord Shiva.

This evening, drive to the old city and explore the narrow streets on foot, after parking the vehicle. You will also see the ghats (embankments by the Ganges) and



enjoy a cycle rickshaw ride.

At the ghats, join the throng of devotees to witness the mesmerising evening aarti ceremony. The rituals are largely performed by Hindu priests – they are well-versed with the Vedas and Upanishads. Donned in traditional attire, they chant mantras and carry out various fascinating rituals. Return to your hotel after the aarti ceremony. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: IN VARANASI

Wake up early in the morning to visit the ghats on time – a magnificent sunrise



awaits you. Also, there will be a memorable boating tour on the Ganges, and you will witness the incredible sight of huge crowds of devotees performing religious rituals, making sun salutations and other memorable acts.

Return to your hotel for breakfast.

Later, this morning, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Varanasi.

Start by visiting some of the important temples such as Bharat Mata Mandir, a unique temple inaugurated by Mahatma Gandhi, which interestingly houses one of the most perfect relief maps of India and is dedicated to Mother India. Another famous one is the Durga Temple, dedicated to Goddess Durga.

In the afternoon, proceed for a guided excursion to SARNATH – where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon.

A major Buddhist centre, Sarnath lies 10 kilometres north east of Varanasi. It was here that Buddha preached his message of the 'middle way' to nirvana after achieving enlightenment at Bodh Gaya. In around 234 BC, Emperor Ashoka, a great follower of Buddhism, erected a stupa here. Between the 3rd century BC and the 11th century AD, several Buddhist structures were built here. Most of the Sarnath's monuments are set in large picturesque gardens.


After your tour of Sarnath, return to the city and spend the evening at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: DEPARTURE

Your tour comes to an end this morning. We will arrange your drop to Varanasi airport, for your onwards flight. (B)

Ranthambore National Park Extension



TOUR OVERVIEW

Amritsar, one of the largest cities in the state of Punjab, has many tales to tell. Not surprising, considering the fact that the destination has witnessed some major events in history. Tourism has long remained a major pillar of the economy here. Amritsar is also a thriving hub of carpet and fabric production, farm produce and handicrafts. So, souvenir hunters can look forward to some awesome collectibles! Quite a few freedom fighters and other eminent personalities have been born here.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVE AMRITSAR

Meeting and assistance on arrival and transfer to hotel in Amritsar.

Amritsar was founded by Guru Ram Das, fourth Guru of the Sikh religion. He settled down next to a pool, said to have miraculous healing powers. His son, Guru Arjun Dev, built the temple within the pool, and later Maharaja Ranjit Singh covered it with pure gold leaf.

Late afternoon, visit the border town the Wagah Border which is one of the points of the Indo-Pak border and every evening the ‘lowering of the flags’ or the ‘Beating Retreat’ ceremony attracts many onlookers. The iron gates are opened and border guards of both the countries lower their respective flags amidst much pomp and show. The atmosphere gets electrified as they try to outdo each other in the drill. After the ceremony return to the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: AMRITSAR

After breakfast, proceed to visit the Golden Temple- the sacred Sikh sanctuary spread out in a vast complex around a huge water tank, in the midst of which stands the marble sanctum where the holy book of the Sikhs, the Guru Granth, is reverently placed. The roof of the sanctum is gold-leafed. The community kitchen provides free meals to up to 10,000 pilgrims and visitors in a day. On the way to the temple, you walk by the busy bazaars of the city and explore the local market.

Also visit the Jallianwala Bagh. It’s a memorial park and symbolizes one of the most tragic moments in India’s freedom movement.

Later visit Durgiana temple dedicated to Goddess Durga. This is a Hindu Temple and has lots of similarities with the Golden Temple.

Late evening, proceed to attend ‘Palki sahib ceremony’ (night ceremony) which happens twice a day. The ceremony involves carrying the holy book Guru Granth Sahib to the Sanctum Santorum early in the morning and carrying it back at

night. It is a symbolic gesture, conducted with utmost devotion and a visual delight. Some particular hymns are read by the respected priest, and finally the book is closed and placed in a golden Palanquin which is carried by all the devotees who

lined up to give offerings. It all happens amidst much chanting and reciting of hymns.

Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: AMRITSAR DEPARTURE

Your tour comes to an end this morning.

We will arrange your drop to Amritsar airport for your onwards flight. (B)



This museum houses a Picture Gallery, which presents the Mahatma's visual biography. Other attractions include the Special Exhibition section, the 'Hall of Relics', and the library.

There is also the popular Tirumalai Nayakar Palace, along with its massive courtyard and grand hall. Return to hotel.

Later tonight, after dinner, again visit the Meenakshi Temple to witness the rituals of 'palliyarai', the last puja of the day. Return for overnight stay at the hotel (B)

You may go boating or ride a rented bicycle on the banks.

The Bryant's Park near the lake is a wonderful botanical garden across 20 acres.

Make your way to La Saleth Church which is more than 130 years old and finally travel to Green Valley View for an excellent panoramic view of the plains.

Return to your hotel by the evening. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)



DAY 03: KODAIKANAL - OOTY (251 KMS – 6 HRS.)

Today, you will drive to Ooty, along the way, you will pass by rubber, tea, cardamom and coffee plantations.



You also get to visit the nearby attractions to experience an all-the-more memorable journey.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL MADURAI

Madurai, the oldest city in the southern state of Tamil Nadu, has an ancient history of global trade. Today, the city is most famous for the Meenakshi Amman Temple, dedicated to Goddess Parvati and her husband, Lord Shiva. The Nayaka Kings laid out the old town in the pattern of a lotus with narrow streets surrounding the Meenakshi Temple at the centre. Later, explore the markets surrounding the temple.

The area is like a huge open-air department store, each street dedicated to one particular item. There is even one lane dedicated to bananas – South India boasts over 50 varieties! Next, visit the Gandhi Museum.

This museum houses a Picture Gallery, which presents the Mahatma's visual biography. Other attractions include the Special Exhibition section, the 'Hall of Relics', and the library. There is also the popular Tirumalai Nayakar Palace, along with its massive courtyard and grand hall. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: MADURAI – RAMESHWARAM (190 KMS – 3 HRS. 30 MINS.)

Start after breakfast for your drive to the holy city of Rameshwaram, which is home to famous temples. On your way stop at Pamban Bridge for pictures.

Arrive into Rameshwaram by lunch time and transfer to your hotel.

This afternoon explore the temples of this town starting with the Badrakali Amman Temple.

Next, pay your respects at the Ramanathaswamy Temple. Dedicated to Shiva, this temple is the biggest attraction of the town. Also, visit Kothandaramaswamy Temple. This iconic temple is dedicated to Lord Rama.

Another highlight is the Panchmukhi Hanuman Temple, dedicated to Lord Hanuman.

Your final stop is Agni Tirtham – one of the



Today, you will drive to Kanyakumari after checking out of your hotel and reach by late afternoon. After freshening up at your hotel in Kanyakumari, head for a bit of sightseeing.

Visit the most famous monument – the Vivekananda Rock Memorial. Back on the mainland, visit the Gandhi Memorial. Also, visit the ancient Kanya Kumari Temple.

The last stop is the beautiful Kanyakumari beach.

DAY 04: KANYAKUMARI – MADURAI, DEPART (245 – 5 HRS) | TRIVANDRUM (96 KMS – 2 HRS)

You may perform a bit of Surya Namaskar by the sea at sunrise. Finally, the tour concludes as you check out and drive to the airport at Madurai (suggested timing should be late afternoon/ evening) for your onward journey.





DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVE HARIDWAR

You are met on arrival at the railway station and assisted with your hotel transfer and check in.

Haridwar is considered to be the gateway of the Gods and one of the holiest pilgrimage spots in the world for Hindus as the river Ganges descends to the flatlands here. The bathing steps or 'ghats' along the river are lined with temples and ashrams. Many sadhus can be spotted here.

This evening, walk through the bustling bazaars to attend the evening prayer (Aarti) dedicated to the Goddess Ganges at the Har-ki-Pauri Ghat. It is a spectacle of sound and colour with the pealing of temple bells and blowing of conch shells. The ritual starts at dusk with the priests lighting lamps and reaches a crescendo, lasting nearly half an hour. Hymns and mantras echo across the banks of the Ganges. Devotees chant along with the clash of cymbals and chiming bells. The reflection of golden hues of floating candles 'Diyas' in the river Ganga is an incredible sight. This is one of the most magical moments in India, a time when one is in communion with both God and nature.

Return to your hotel after the ceremony. Overnight stay at the hotel

DAY 02: HARIDWAR – EXCURSION TO RISHIKESH (21 KMS – 1 HR.)

You take a day trip to Rishikesh today after breakfast.

There is plenty to do in Rishikesh and you will start the tour from Lakshman Jhula- the popular hanging bridge across the holy river Ganga. Its 450ft long and is built at a height of 70ft from the river and 3kms away from Rishikesh city. Next, walk over Ram Jhula, another iron suspension bridge on river Ganga. It connects Muni ki Reti with Swargashram.

Later, visit the different Ashrams of Rishikesh such as Sivananda Ashram, Parmath Niketan Temple, Gita Bhavan, Swarg Ashram, Maa Anandamayee Ashram, Saptrishi Ashram, and of course the recently restored Beatles Ashram.


Time permitting, take a stroll through the local markets as well before resuming your drive back to Haridwar, arriving by evening. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)

TOUR OVERVIEW

Shimla, one of India's most famous hill stations, derives its name from Goddess Shyamala, an incarnation of Goddess Kali, the deity of power and wrath. However, unlike its name, Shimla is a perfect heaven for the ones in search of tranquillity. Nature has blessed this capital city of Himachal Pradesh with innumerable gifts and man has used them to make Shimla one of India's best locales.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL SHIMLA

You will be met on arrival in Shimla and assisted with the transfer to your hotel.

Spend the rest of the day at your leisure and enjoy the comfort of the hotel. You can also delight yourself in the tranquil beauty of the surroundings or take a leisurely walk in the compound of the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: SHIMLA

After breakfast, proceed for a sightseeing tour, starting with a drive to Kufri. The drive takes 45 mins (14 km).

Nestled at an elevation of 8000 ft. above sea level, Kufri is a popular hill station in the Shimla district. The scenic views have won over visitors from all parts of the world.

Make sure that you check out the Indira Bungalow – absolutely spectacular views of the surrounding landscapes await you here. Then, visit Himalayan Zoo, also known as Himalayan Nature Park or Kufri Zoo – this is the natural habitat of many species of rich flora and fauna.

After the zoo, drive back to Shimla, where you spend the rest of the day, exploring the local sights, including the Vice Regal Lodge, which was the summer residence of the British viceroy of India. The well-manicured gardens make for a pleasant stroll.

Continue walking towards the Mall to Scandal Point, known to be the place where Prince of Patiala flirted with the daughter of the Viceroy of India and thus the scandal. The Patiala Prince was banished from Shimla and he then built another town with its own palace at Chail.

The other heritage buildings we will see are the General Post Office, Christ's Church, built in the neo-Gothic style in 1857 to serve the British community, the Town Hall and the Gaiety Theatre. Another magnificent sight is the Gorton Castle with



its red galvanized iron roofing, giving it a fairy-tale feel, when seen from a distance. Its red towers stand out brightly amid the surrounding deodar trees and the Vidhan Sabha, which was inaugurated by Lord Reading, the then Viceroy of India, on August 27, 1925.

Return to your hotel by the evening. Overnight stay at the hotel. (B)

DAY 03: SHIMLA

The day is at your leisure for independent

activities. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 04: DEPARTURE SHIMLA

The tour comes to an end today.

After breakfast, check out and drive back to either Delhi or Chandigarh for the next leg of your onward journey. (B)

This evening, stroll down the colourful Sadar Bazaar, near the Clock Tower. The bazaar offers plenty of souvenir hunting prospects. Highlights include string puppets, slippers, and the famous tie and die fabrics. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 02: JODHPUR – UDAIPUR (250 KMS – 5 HRS.)

After breakfast, check out and enjoy a tour of the city before driving to Udaipur.

Start the tour with a visit to the magnificent Mehrangarh Fort. Replete with ornate red sandstone carvings, its top highlights include the gorgeous Phool Mahal, the Sheesh Mahal, and the alluring Moti Mahal. After Mehrangarh, head to the Jaswant Thada. This burial ground of the rulers of Marwar, was built in 1899 by Maharaj Sardar Singh, as a royal cenotaph, to commemorate his father, Maharaja Jaswant Sing II, the 33rd Rathore ruler.

After the sightseeing, embark on your drive to Udaipur. On the way, stop at the white marble temples of Ranakpur. The entire place, including the extraordinary collection of 1144 uniquely carved pillars, the richly decorated ceilings, and the friezes depicting the lives of the 24 Jain Tirthankaras (gurus) is fascinating. Continue with your drive to Udaipur. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and spend the evening at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel (B)

DAY 03: UDAIPUR

After breakfast, visit the City Palace.

This sprawling palace was built over three centuries and is a series of four interconnecting palaces, illustrative of various architectural styles. Of particular note here is the exquisite collection of priceless Rajput Miniature Paintings done in the Mewari tradition.

Also walk through the Crystal Gallery which has a rather eclectic collection of crystal d'art and furniture, including a complete bedroom set.

You may also visit Bagore Ki Haveli.

This gracious 18th-century haveli, set on the water's edge in the Gangaur Ghat area, was built by a Mewar prime minister and has since been carefully restored. The haveli also houses a gallery featuring a


fascinating collection of period photos of Udaipur and a surreal collection of world-famous monuments carved out of polystyrene.



Head to Chaura Rasta, known for branded showrooms and antique bookstores. Continue through the famous Bapu bazaar, which features Mojri footwear, soft-leather items, colourful block printed fabrics from Jaipur, and more. Next up is the Johri bazaar, which has Jaipuri quilts, colourful turbans, and traditional Kundan jewellery.


